

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1 - Exhibits previously entered in national or international competition are respectfully declined and may be entered in the Court of Honour.
- 2 - Note: Maximum number of frames per exhibit is eight. (Six pages per frame.)
- 3 - The exhibition is open to all paid up members of any stamp club who are exhibiting their own material and who have prepared their own material for the exhibition. More than one entry per exhibitor is allowed provided that the subject matter is different.
- 4 - All entries are to be mounted in six-page frames and are to be delivered to Community Christian Reformed Church, 1275 Bleams Road, at Fischer-Hallman Road, in Kitchener, **between 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. on the day of the show.**
- 5 - Exhibits will remain on display until 4:00 p.m. on the day of the show when they will be removed by the exhibitor.
- 6 - All exhibits will be treated with due care and given suitable protection. However, the Kitchener-Waterloo Philatelic Society, the Exhibition Committee, the Church and its staff will accept no responsibility for loss or damage to any exhibit or part of any exhibit. Please arrange your own insurance, if deemed necessary.
- 7 - Entry forms are to be sent to [P.O. Box 904, Station C, Kitchener, Ontario, N2G 4C5](#). Entry **deadline is March 31, 2010. No exceptions will be made.**
- 8 - Any exhibit entered incorrectly will be transferred to its proper class at the discretion of the show committee.
- 9 - Exhibits will be judged according to accepted standards of philatelic achievements by a panel of experienced judges. The decision of the judges will be final in all cases.
- 10 - Any previous **BEST IN SHOW** or **GOLD** award exhibit at any stamp exhibition is ineligible for competition unless at least 60% of the exhibited material has been changed.
- 11 - Novice exhibitors may submit 8 1/2" X 11" pages for display purposes with a limit of six pages per exhibitor. A novice exhibit can be limited to a single page but must be suitably protected in transparent covers. These pages may be mounted into frames on the morning of the show. All non-competitive novice exhibits will be suitably recognized.
- 12 - No entry fee is required.
