A Little Bit About Our Club's Finances

To many people a long list of numbers is a bore, even when they know that those numbers mean dollars. However, the KWPS Executive and Directors take the management of your club's money very seriously, and they make sure that money is always available to provide stamp collecting and philatelic services to you, our members.

For instance, did you know that.....

- We carry \$2 million of liability insurance in case anything goes seriously wrong at our meetings or at Stampfest?
- Our website, which you can find at www.kwstampclub.org/, costs us about \$280.00 a year to maintain?
- The monthly prize draws that you faithfully support bring in over \$200.00 annually?
- The show cards for Stampfest cost over \$100.00 to get printed?
- We pay close to \$100.00 for each issue of the Grand News that is sent to us?
- Our speakers and show judges receive honorariums of about \$50.00?
- The Stampfest church hall that we rent cost \$375.00 in 2006? This year it cost over \$200.00 more.
- Our revenue this year exceeded \$4,400.00, but the expenses were just under \$4,000.00?

If you ever have questions about the club's finances, please see the treasurer, George Pepall, or any member of the Executive. George will gladly share with you the club's latest financial statements.

KWPS Club Auctions - Part 2

In the previous newsletter I described the basic workings of our club auctions. In this article I will provide more detail on buying at one of our sales.

If you are interested in buying, there are usually 30 to 40 individual lots offered in each sale. Almost any type of material can appear, but for our club sales the material is usually fairly inexpensive. I should qualify my use of the word 'inexpensive', as we all know that many treasures in our collections are often the items we find that don't cost a lot of money and may be one-of-a-kind, or very hard to find.

The lots are laid out on three or four tables at the beginning of each meeting at approximately 7:00pm.

TIP: It is highly recommended that you inspect any lot(s) you may be interested in, to ensure that the condition is satisfactory and the item is as described.

To begin bidding all you have to do is sign-up for a bidder

number on the bidder number list, which is laid out on the tables. Once you have a bidder number you can bid on any of the lots for sale that evening. Many of the lots have a 'reserve' or 'starting bid'. This is to protect the seller who may want to ensure that his or her material does not sell for an unreasonably low price.

TIP: the first bid can be equal to the reserve – you do not have to bid higher than the reserve if you are the first bidder!

We have established bidding increments and all this does is to standardize how much more you have to bid over the previous bid. Our bidding increments are 25 cents for bids up to \$5; 50 cents for bids between \$5 and \$10; \$1 for bids between \$10 and \$30; and \$2 for bids over \$30.

So, you have found a lot that you like and you placed a bid. Congratulations, but the sale is not over yet! We usually allow bidding to take place up to 8:00 pm. At that point everyone is asked to step back, the bidding is closed, and the



lots are gathered up by the auctioneer.

TIP: after you place a bid, you may want to watch the lot to monitor whether someone else outbids you. Some people will wait to the last minute. In online auctions like eBay this is known as "sniping".

Please check-in with the auctioneer to pay for any lots you may have won. I try to wrap up the sale as soon after 8:00 pm as I can.

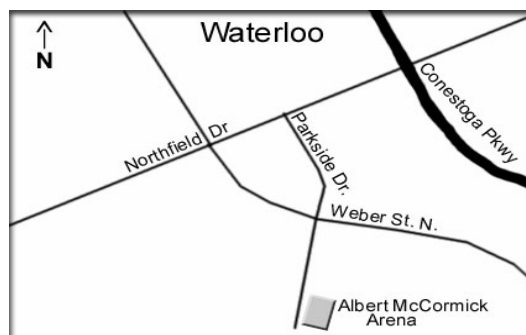
