


JC Wilson Sports Series –No. 11 Football and Lacrosse, New Mills NB, Sept 8th, 1899 Plus nine-bar hand cancel

Date is earlier than the recorded date of issue of the Stamp!




Yukon Territory –Steamer Dawson at Five Fingers

Sept 1st, 1903 Split Ring Cancel






EB Eddy Co. -Hull, PQ 1899-1902



Who needs it dated! One of many businesses using bulk mail to advertise their wares.


Gordon Mackay & Co. Using One Cent Queen Victoria

Stamps to pre-pay the bulk rate for cards delivered to an addressee. 1899 & 1902










#### An Illustrated Philatelic Glossary

#### "SOUVENIR SHEET"

As a souvenir of an event being honoured with a postage stamp, some countries will issue a sheet of 1 or more stamps with additional information or illustrations on the sheet selvege to produce a souvenir of the event.

These illustrated miniature sheets are usually called "Souvenir Sheets".

These sheets issued by Guyana to honour The 16th Scout World Jamboree, held in Australia. The \$10 stamp was issued in larger sheets as well as this "Souvenir Sheet" but the \$8 stamp was available as a "Souvenir Sheet" only.
