An Illustrated Philatelic Glossary "CINDERELLAS"

Stamps, not valid for postage, issued by either Postal Authorities or others, to publicize some cause or event. Philatelists tend to call these stamps "Cinderellas".

This miniature sheet of 8 "Cinderellas", was issued to publicize the 9th Boy Scout World Jamboree.



Occasionally an outside group {such as, in this case, a Venture Scout Unit} may issue stamps to raise funds by providing a special service; in this case the delivery of Christmas Greeting Cards locally on Christmas Eve.

These are often referred to as "Semi-official Cinderellas", as they were approved by the Post Office, but issued by the Boy Scouts in Sheffield England.
