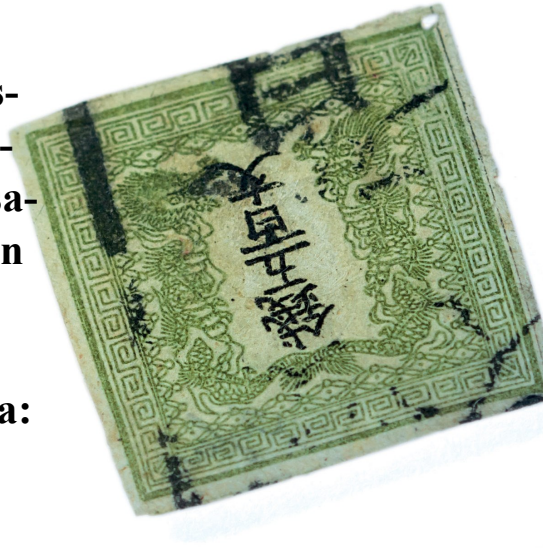

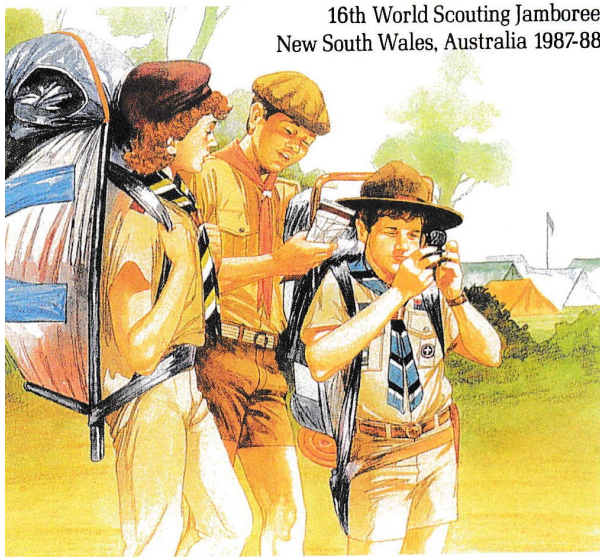

## An Illustrated Philatelic Glossary

### “CACHET”

A picture or design on an envelope honouring an event or the topic of the stamp



Cachets are usually used to honour: First Flights, First Day of Issue, or events such as Boy Scout Jamborees

This Australian cover shows a group of Scouts and Honours the 16th World Jamboree

The New Zealand cover below shows a photo of Lord Robert Baden Powell of Gilwell and honours the subject of the stamp - i.e. Pan - Pacific Scout Jamboree 1959
